NOTICE TO LICENSEES

DATE: AUGUST 28, 2002

TO: ALL NONRESTRICTED LICENSEES AND INTERESTED PERSONS

Pursuant to NRS 463.750(2), the Nevada Gaming Commission is accepting public input on (i) the legality of interactive gaming; (ii) technical safeguards relating to the security and reliability of interactive gaming systems and reasonable assurances that players will be of lawful age and communicating only from jurisdictions where such communications are lawful; and (iii) the public policy of the State of Nevada to foster the stability and success of gaming, as it relates to interactive gaming. Interested parties may submit written materials on or before November 30, 2002, to the Nevada Gaming Commission, P.O. Box 8003, Carson City, Nevada, 89702.

In addition, interested parties may appear before the Nevada Gaming Commission and make presentations of up to 15 minutes at the September 26, October 24, and November 21, 2002, meetings. Interested parties may reserve a 15-minute time period on any of those agendas by contacting Marc Warren at (775) 684-7791. The Commission will attempt to accommodate parties who have not reserved any specific time, as its schedule permits.
